Haymakers Jig

This is a long dance done in double jig time. Partners face each other, gents in one line & ladies in the other (usually 5 people in each line). Right foot directly in front of the left foot with your weight on your left foot. The Top of the line is on the gent's left and the "Bottom" of the line is on the gent's right. Holding hands along the line, the dance starts as follows:

Bars Step

- 8 All Advance & Retire twice
- 4 All Jig step (right & left foot)
- 4 All Advance & Retire
- 4 Top Gent Right hand to Bottom Lady (first couple), turn & Home
- 4 Top Lady Right hand to Bottom Gent (second couple), turn & Home
- 4 Top Gent Left hand to Bottom Lady, turn & Home
- 4 Top Lady Left hand to Bottom Gent, turn & Home
- 8 Top Gent Swing with Bottom Lady & Home
- 8 Top Lady Swing with Bottom Gent & Home

Interlace

- Tops join right hands and turn 1 ½ times, left hand to the opposite line, right hand to your partner, continue chain to "Bottom" of line
- 8 Tops Swing to Home position
- 16 Tops Cast off & Lead Line Around

Repeat with a new Top couple - 4 times
