## Garoon or Karoun

Both spellings are correct; they are merely dialect differences. The dance was created and choreographed by Tom Bozigian from steps learned in his youth in Fresno during the 1950s. It is from a group of dances that won dance contests during that time at the various Armenian Youth Federation Conventions held periodically throughout California.

**Formation:** Mixed line with little fingers joined at shoulder height ("W" position). **Rhythm:** 2/4

## Figure I

- 1-2 Facing slightly R and moving in LOD, do 2 two-steps, beg R (cts 1 & 2, 1 & 2) arms move slightly R & L like windshield wipers
- 3 Turning to face ctr, step R to R (ct 1) swing L in front of R (ct 2)
- 4 Step L in place (ct 1); swing R in front of L (ct 2)
- 5 Releasing fingers, walk R, L in LOD as hands clap twice (once on each step) at chest ht.
- 6 Turning to face ctr, step R over L and rejoin fingers (ct 1) hop back on R as L lifts behind (body remains erect) (ct 2)
- 7 Step L bkwd as R toe pivots outward (heel remains on floor) (ct 1) repeat ct 1 with opp footwork (ct 2)
- 8 Step L bkwd (ct 1) stamp R beside L without wt (ct 2)

Do Fig. I, 4 times in all

## Meas Figure II

- 1 Facing slightly R and moving LOD, step R as arms lower to sides (ct 1) hop on R as L lifts behind (ct 2)
- 2 Beginning with L, do 1 two-step as arms raise to "W" pos (cts 1 & 2)
- 3-4 Repeat meas 1-2 (2 times in all)
- 5-6 Releasing fingers, make 1 complete turn to R stepping R, L, R (cts 1, 2, 1); Women rotate hands during turn "Yeghneek"; touch ball of L ft next to R as hands clap at chest level (ct 2)
- 7-8 Repeat meas 5-6 with opp ftwk and direction

Do Fig. II, 4 times in all

Yeghneek (deer symbol): Woman's hands rotation.

Hands above head, palms out; thumbs down to form half circles with middle finger; other fingers straight. Hands rotate up, in, down, out.

Note: Do Fig. I to chorus and Fig. II to verses
