Formation: Open circle with leader

Position: Arms in W position

Meter: 2/4

Meas Introduction

1-32 No action, facing centre, begin with wt on L ft

Meas **Figure 1** (Begin dance with arms in W position)

- Touch with R toes to R (1), step on R ft in place, turning to face LOD (2)
- Facing LOD, touch L toes twd ctr of circle (1), step L ft fwd in LOD (2)
- Facing LOD, touch R toes behind (1), step on R ft fwd (2)
- 4 Step L ft fwd (1), step R ft fwd (2)
- 5 Lift on R heel, while turning to face ctr and bringing arms fwd and down to V position (1), step on L ft behind R ft swinging arms bkwd (2)
- Facing ctr, step R ft to R swinging arms fwd (1), step L ft behind R ft swinging arms bkwd (2)
- With arms in bkwd V position, touch R toes to R (1), turning to face LOD and raising hands to W- position, step R ft in place (2)

Repeat dance from meas 2 until end of music.
